

Robinson Canyon, LT Murray.

Driving Directions:

From Seattle, drive east on Interstate 90 to **exit 101 for Thorp**

At the end of the exit ramp, turn **right**.

Drive about 0.75 mile before turning **right on Killmore Road** (where main road veers to the left). Drive Killmore Road 2.4 miles,

right on Robinson Canyon Road (pavement gives way to gravel in 0.5 mile) and drive 1.5 miles to reach the elk fence gate. Open gate, drive through to meadow and park. (close gate after driving through). Creek on right hand side for stock watering. Some trees for Hi lining. No outhouses. No picnic tables.

Majority is rocky footing, so recommend shoes on your stock. This is an elk feeding station area, so often elk and deer antler sheds are found. Recommend small groups, 6 or less. Fabulous views and wildflowers. Keep eyes and ears alert for rattlesnakes. You don't bite them they don't bite you...respect their space.

***PLEASE NOTE: Each winter the gates are locked and the area is closed to all public access for the protection of wintering elk. The closure begins upon initiation of supplemental feeding, typically in early to mid-December, and access reopens May 1.

Requires State Discover Pass. Does not require certified weed seed free hay.
